Volunteer Staff Classroom Guidelines

Please review these guidelines, then sign and return the bottom portion to the office. Thank You!

Choose your battles—Keep control of the classroom but realize you are dealing with streetwise kids who often have ADD, ADHD, or Alcoholic Syndrome. Some of the children were born as crack babies; some have been beaten, sexually assaulted or raped.

Rock House Kids volunteers need to be above reproach as the Bible tells us and we need to set the example:

No smoking on premises.

No coarse jokes of any kind.

No special type of hugs or touching (age appropriate hugs only).

Do not bring gifts to the children.

Do not give out money.

Do not promise your class any special outings, you must check with Executive Director to do so. (Remember: you would need to have permission slips from parents and Rock House Kids is ultimately responsible for these children when they are with you.)

We are one big family treating all the kids in all classrooms equally. If you have any special ideas, please come see a staff member first.

Bathroom breaks should be kept to a minimum during classroom time. Kids who are bored in class will use this time to lollygag to and from the restroom or check out what other classrooms are doing. Please be aware.

Please be aware of the classrooms around you and the noise you might be making. Please try to keep the noise level down to a conversation level.

Playing games and doing crafts are encouraged but please try to keep the focus on the Word of God at all times.

Please make sure to tell a staff member of any troubling incidents with the kids and why you are expelling them before you leave for the night or call RHK (815-962-5067) the next day with details.

You may use the TV's. We have supplies, and crafts in the Teacher/supply room.

Please do not bring in special gifts for one student if you do not intend on bringing one for each child in your class. This is not a requirement.
